## Emmaus

Emmaus is an intergenerational, whole community monthly event aimed at discipleship for our Parish community. In the Gospel of Luke 24:13-35, we see two men walking the road to Emmaus, discussing the Passion of Jesus. Suddenly, Jesus appears to them, yet they do not recognize Him. As they walk and talk, Jesus explains the Scriptures to them and “their hearts burn within them” as he speaks. At the end of the journey, in the breaking of the bread, they recognize Jesus, only to have Him vanish. Immediately, they run out and share their encounter with the risen Lord.

Our vision for Emmaus is captured in this Scripture; that we would **walk together, discuss Scripture, encounter Jesus, and share what we have learned** so that we are “forming into missionary disciples.”
